

Dear parent,

In a short while, we will be conducting the Bike Rider Test where the abilities of the class as bike riders are tested.

Your child will be participating:

What is the Bike Rider Test?

The Bike Rider Test has the following elements:

- Traffic regulation training and how to ride your bike safely;
- Bicycle check;
- A bike ride on public roads where your child will be following a pre-defined route in order to demonstrate what he or she has learned.

What should you do?

- You are required to make sure your child brings a legal bicycle and a bicycle helmet on the day of the Test.
- You could take your child for practice runs so that he or she will be comfortable with it. Please refer to the attached document to see the route.

What are the requirements for a legal bicycle?

- Front wheel brake
- Rear wheel brake
- Bell
- A white reflector on the front
- A red reflector on the rear
- Two yellow reflectors, one on each pedal
- Yellow reflectors in the spokes or a white reflector stripe on the tires
- Bicycle lights - for when it is dark
- A lock
